

**Summary of Immunization Requirements for School, Daycare & Head Start**

<b>By the time a child is this age:</b>	<b>These immunizations are required for attendance:</b>
<b>&lt; 3 months</b>	None
<b>3 months</b>	1 DTaP 1 Polio 1 Hib 1 Hepatitis B 1 PCV
<b>5 months</b>	2 DTaP 2 Polio 2 Hib 2 Hepatitis B 2 PCV
<b>7 months</b>	3 DTaP 2 Polio 2 Hib 2 Hepatitis B 3 PCV (or 2 PCV if first dose given between 7 – 11 months of age)
<b>12 months</b>	3 DTaP 2 Polio 3 Hib (or 2 Hib between 12 – 15 months of age) 2 Hepatitis B 4 PCV (with one dose on or after 12 months of age)
<b>16 months</b>	4 DTaP 2 Polio 3 or 4 Hib (depending on type of vaccine)- last dose must be on or after 12 months of age 2 Hepatitis B 4 PCV (with one dose on or after 12 months of age) 1 MMR 1 Varicella (unless child has been diagnosed w/ chickenpox disease)
<b>19 months</b>	4 DTaP 3 IPV 3 or 4 Hib (depending on type of vaccine)- last dose must be on or after 12 months of age 3 Hepatitis B 4 PCV (with one dose on or after 12 months of age) 1 MMR 1 Varicella (unless child has been diagnosed w/ chickenpox disease)
<b>48 months</b>	4 DTaP 3 Polio 3 or 4 Hib (depending on type of vaccine)- last dose must be on or after 12 months of age 3 Hepatitis B 4 PCV (with one dose on or after 12 months of age) 2 MMR 2 Varicella (unless child has been diagnosed w/ chickenpox disease)

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<b>By the time a child is this age:</b>	<b>These immunizations are required for attendance:</b>
<b>5 years</b>	5 DTaP (5 <sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 4 <sup>th</sup> dose given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 4 Polio (4 <sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 3 Hepatitis B 2 MMR 2 Varicella (unless child has been diagnosed w/ chickenpox disease)
<b>7 years (see exceptions)</b>	5 DTaP (5 <sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 4 <sup>th</sup> dose given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) (or a dose of Td preceded by (2) doses of tetanus/ diphtheria containing vaccines) 4 Polio (4 <sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 3 Hepatitis B 1 MMR and 1 measles containing vaccine *2 MMR *2 Varicella (unless child has been diagnosed w/ chickenpox disease)
<b>Sixth grade entry Age 11-12 years or older</b>	5 DTaP (5 <sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 4 <sup>th</sup> dose given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 4 Polio (4 <sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 3 Hepatitis B 2 MMR 2 Varicella (unless child has been diagnosed w/ chickenpox disease) 1 Tdap - regardless of interval from last tetanus containing vaccine 1 Meningococcal
<b>7 - 12 grades (see exceptions)</b>	5 DTaP (5 <sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 4 <sup>th</sup> dose given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 4 Polio (4 <sup>th</sup> dose not needed if 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose given after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday) 3 Hepatitis B 1 MMR and 1 measles containing vaccine *2 MMR 1 Td booster *2 Varicella (unless child has been diagnosed w/ chickenpox disease) *1 Tdap *1 Meningococcal

**\*Exceptions:**

- **Currently enrolled 1-5<sup>th</sup> and 7-12<sup>th</sup> graders will not be required to meet the new immunization requirements but are highly recommended to**
